UMK, through the Institute for Poverty Research and Management (InsPeK) will engage in research activities with Albukhary Centre of Excellence on Socio-Economic Development and Innovation (ACE-SEDI) in specific areas designed to improve socio-economic status of community in rural areas of Baling and Sik, Kedah.

The delegation from UMK headed by the Vice Chancellor, YBhg. Prof. Dato' Ts. Dr. Noor Azizi Ismail toured the Campus during the courtesy visit and they were impressed to see the state-of-art facilities at AIU.



Meanwhile, the Vice Chancellor and President of AIU, YBhg. Prof. Dato' Dr. Abd. Aziz Tajuddin thanked UMK for being the first public university to seal MoU with the University. He also highlighted that AIU and UMK share so many things in common, to eradicate poverty through social entrepreneurship and social business.


