

The first LC Buddies project was a knowledge sharing session and Language Games Day with the English Club from Politeknik Sultan Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah (POLIMAS), in March 2020.

Currently, LC Buddies organising a Webinar Series where AIU students can not only display their proficiency and talent, but also share their unique experiences by giving talks on a variety of topics. The first talk by (LCBW#1) was given by SBSS student Omar Bah with the topic "Cultivating the Love of Reading and How It Can Help You". RESUME WRITING AND INTERVIEWING SKILLS WORKSHOP

A Resume Writing and Job Interviewing Skills Workshop was conducted via Google Meet by Dr Kamalesh from SBSS, specifically targeted at the Cohort 1 & Cohort 2 students who will be starting their industrial training next year. This workshop was held on 25 November 2020 (1st Session) from 3pm-5.15pm and 2nd session on 27th November 2020 from 4.30pm-5.30pm. 51 students participated in the workshop, in which the first session focused on resume writing with the practice of resume preparation, whereas the second session was based on interviewing skills and tips.

The purpose of the workshop was to prepare students to learn how to produce an effective resume, a complete cover letter and exclusive interview guidelines. Furthermore, students also gained skills to compose a professional resume and cover letter to grasp key points of interview. It is aligned with AIU's expectation to develop capable graduates who can succeed in the current labor market. In the first session, students were exposed with a one-hour briefing related to design tips for an effective resume and another one and a half hour allocated for the students to practice preparing the resume and cover letter themselves. The second session emphasized on the briefing about effective interview skills and Q&A session with students for one hour duration.

At the end of the workshop, students were able to prepare a resume and cover letter and provided with constructive feedback for improvement. It is expected that the students feel more confident in their preparation for job application and interview. Besides, it is essential for the students to understand the needs of potential employers by sharpening their skills and experiences to fit those needs. Hopefully, this workshop is organised annually to train students in soft skills development which will help them to better prepare for interviews and market themselves in front of the future employers. So, this would be a great opportunity for the students to enhance their credibility and be more confident and excel in their future career.

THE HULT PRIZE COMPETITION

Albukhary International University was selected to host its first local edition of the Hult Prize On-Campus Finals, the world's largest student competition for the development of new social enterprises.

In partnership with the United Nations Foundation, the Hult Prize is the most massive youth movement launched by the Hult International Business School to solve urgent social problems through business. The objective of the Hult movement is to create among young people the next generation of social entrepreneurs, mainly university students.

The Hult Prize comprises of (4) steps, including the On-Campus Finals, the Regional Summits, the Global Accelerators and the United Nations Global Finals, in which the winning team will receive USD 1 million in seed funds to create their own start-up company at the UN Finals. In August, Meshach B. Koley, campus director for the Hult Prize at AIU, proposed and revealed that the Vice Chancellor and President, the Honourable Professor Dato' Dr Abd Aziz Bin Tajuddin has approved to host the local version of the competition. The Director of the Student Affairs department, Honourable Dato' Siti Zubaidah A. Hamid appointed Assoc. Prof. Dr Suraya Hanim Mokhtar, Dean for the School of Business and Social Sciences, as the advisor of the event. Throughout, Meshach was sure that his colleagues on campus had as good a chance as anyone else to go all the way and win the Hult Prize.

Meshach said, "I believe that social enterprises have the power to change the world and that AIU students have the potential to make that change,"Since August, participants have walked through a series of briefings on the competition process, pitching, preparation and many more to prepare the teams for the on-campus round since the announcement of the Hult Prize at AIU.

Furthermore, the finals of the local Hult Prize edition at AIU are also ready to host its final on-campus competition, scheduled for 9 December 2020, with a total of 13 teams participating, as the teams are ready to lead a generation that will change the world through business. The on-campus rounds will also allow top-notch judges to pick one winning team that will represent AIU at the next stage of the for good-for-profit movement at AIU.









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
