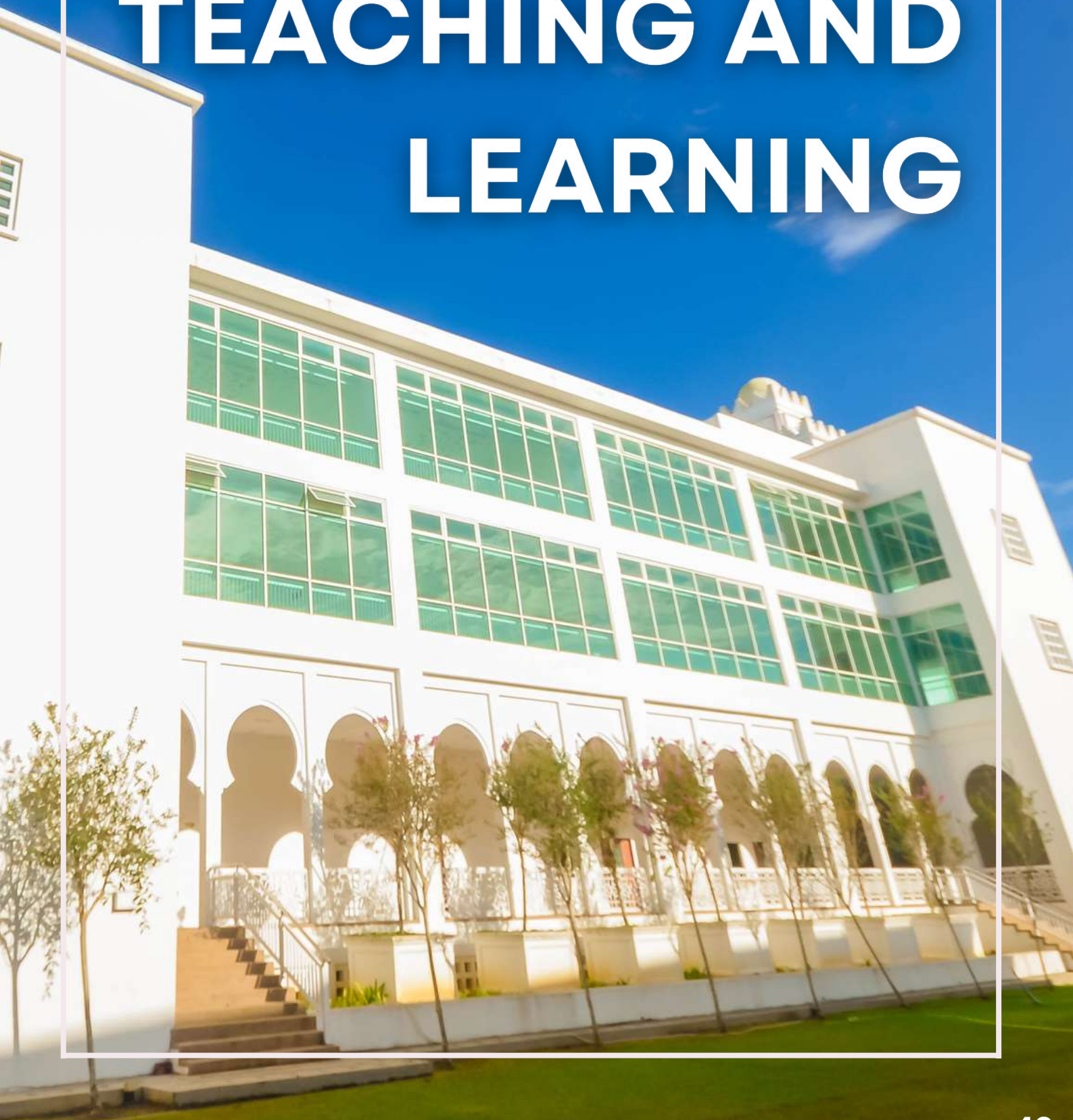
UUM SCHOOL OF TECHNOLOGY MANAGEMENT AND LOGISTICS (STML)

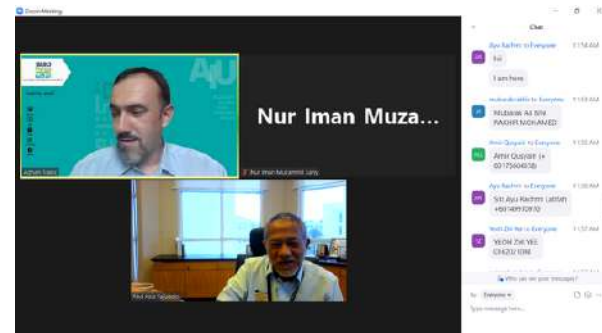
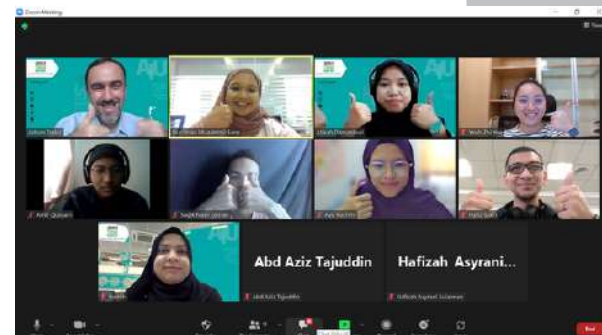
Associate. Prof. Dr. Adnan Trakic, our second speaker from Alumni Talk Series. The topic for these alumni is Basic Contract Law.

Through SULAM, students may have a deeper understanding of the course content which will promote their problem solving and interpersonal skills. Eventually it will benefit back to the society through knowledge sharing. Participants were exposed to the four approaches of SULAM which are direct (face-to-face), indirect (environment project), advocacy (educate the community), and research-based approach. Q&A session was conducted at the end to address the questions raised.

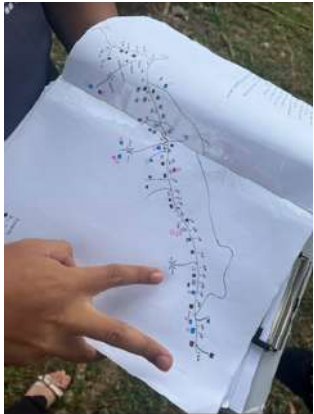
