Appreciation for Support: Earthquake Relief Donation for Myanmar

Following the devastating earthquake that struck Myanmar on March 28, 2025, causing widespread damage and loss, AIU students from Myanmar led a compassionate initiative to support those affected. AMSA quickly launched a donation campaign from March 30 to April 4, rallying the support of students, lecturers, and the public. Through this collective effort, a total of RM 8,601.07 (MMK 8,600,000) was raised. These funds were used to deliver much-needed aid to impacted individuals in Mandalay and Sagaing, in collaboration with trusted organizations, and to assist families within the AIU Myanmar community. We are deeply grateful for the generosity shown by all contributors, whose support brought meaningful relief and hope to those in need.
