Malaysia's Leadership in Peacemaking Recognised at AICHR Thematic Study Launch

The ASEAN Intergovernmental Commission on Human Rights (AICHR) launched the Thematic Study on the Right to Peace, alongside the Regional Training Programme on Human Rights, gathering academics, ASEAN representatives, and civil society actors to discuss peacebuilding in Southeast Asia. Representing Albukhary International University (AIU), Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ayesah Uy Abubakar highlighted Malaysia's role in facilitating the Philippine peace process with the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF), its peace education initiatives, and the vital contribution of civil society to sustaining peace across the region.
