Three Decades of Peacebuilding in Bosnia and Herzegovina: From Initial Success to Reversal

The School of Business and Social Sciences at Albukhary International University hosted an engaging talk titled "Three Decades of Peacebuilding in Bosnia and Herzegovina: From Initial Success to Reversal" by Visiting Professor Dr. Emir Hadžikadunić at the university's Auditorium. The session brought together staff and academics to examine the country's journey since the end of conflict, highlighting early achievements in post-war reconstruction, governance reforms, and societal rebuilding. Dr. Emir Hadžikadunić also discussed the political, economic, and social challenges that have gradually reversed much of this progress, drawing parallels to other global conflict zones. The talk provided participants with valuable historical context, critical perspectives on peacebuilding strategies, and lessons that can inform future international efforts toward lasting stability and development.
