#### AIU Moves Forward Towards ISO 21001:2018 Certification

Albukhary International University (AIU) has taken another big step towards excellence after successfully completing the Stage 1 Audit for the ISO 21001:2018 Educational Organizations Management System (EOMS) on 3 September 2025 at AIU, Alor Setar. Conducted by Mr. Saravanan from Bureau Veritas and coordinated by the Centre for Quality Assurance and Accreditation (CQAA), the one-day session evaluated AIU's readiness for the next stage of certification. Led by Prof. Dr. Hj. Mohamad Abdullah bin Hemdi, Deputy Vice President (Academic), and supported by 10 internal auditors, the audit highlighted AIU's strong culture of quality and continuous improvement. With valuable insights and 22 documentation findings identified for refinement, the team is now set to gear up for the Stage 2 Audit in mid-October 2025, moving closer to achieving ISO 21001:2018 certification.
